Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the new school year. I hope that you all had a lovely summer and that you are ready for the school year ahead. I would especially like to welcome the children and families who are new to our school community. I hope that you will have a very happy and fulfilling time here.

It was a quiet summer compared to last year when we had a big extension project but there was still a lot of work done. Our local Community Association organised for the painting of the school shed in the yard. When the building work is completed we will replace the art work. We rearranged the pictures on the corridors and hung up new ones. Please feel free to come in and have a look at them after school any day. There was the usual maintenance and cleaning work as well so that the school looks great and ready for the children and staff. Over the last few days the staff have been in making sure that everything is ready and their dedication to their work is fantastic. Thanks to the Cogan family for tidying up the garden and trees. 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We will have a range of after school classes running this year. You will receive notes from the organisers of these classes over the next week or so. We have arranged for tennis, drama, art and craft and modern dance to be offered so far and we hope to have more soon. The school is facilitating the organisation of these classes but you will be entering into an arrangement with the class organiser so all queries and money will need to go directly to them. These are optional classes and our teachers will continue to run extra-curricular activities such as football, hurling, chess etc. Children are allowed into the school yard from 8.30 am and will be allowed into their classrooms at 8.40 am. Formal classes begin at 8.50 am. No responsibility can be taken for children before 8.30 am or after school unless on official school activities. We receive very strict guidelines from our insurance company so we have to stick to these times even if it is wet or cold. Please bear this in mind when you drop your child to school.

You will receive information about the pupil insurance scheme shortly. I would encourage you to avail of it. Accidents happen both at home and in school and this insurance has proven to be priceless for families over the years that have taken it up. It pays out quickly and is relatively hassle free. Please feel free to talk to me about it, if you have any questions.

Each teacher will communicate with you via notes and your child's homework journal. Please check regularly for notes. We will continue to use Text-A-Parent so make sure that we have your most up to date contact details. I will send home a newsletter each month to keep you updated on school news. Uniforms: Children are to wear black shoes that they can run and play in with their uniforms and plain runners (not bright multi-coloured runners or high tops) with their tracksuits.
