Child Rescue Ireland (CRI) Alert is a public alert system that An Garda Síochána can use to let you know when a child is abducted and ask for your help in finding that child. CRI Alert sends the message of the child abduction out to the public through the media, road signs, social network sites, bus & rail companies, health service, ports and the CRI Alert Smartphone App. An Garda Síochána will only launch a CRI Alert in the most serious child abduction cases where there is a known risk to the child's life.
