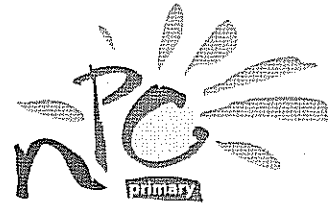

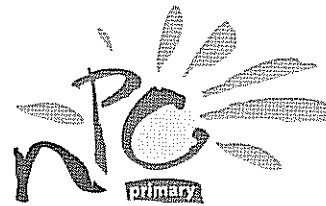

Internet Safety Talk on February 10th

Each year, around the world, **Safer Internet Day** is celebrated in the second week of February. This year during that week the NPC Cork East County Branch is organising an Internet Safety talk in the Radisson Blu Hotel & Spa, Little Island, Cork.

Safer Internet Day is an initiative to promote a safer Internet for all users, especially young people and we are particularly focussing our talk on parents of primary school children. As parents, it is vital to have good, open communication with your children about their internet lives. Like all other aspects of their lives, we need to talk to our children about the potential dangers that they may come across online as well as the many benefits they will find. Setting rules and boundaries around children's Internet usage is an important aspect of keeping them safe on-line.

The session focuses on strategies for improving communication between parents and children and negotiating boundaries to their internet use. Parents will be introduced to strategies to help their children be responsible, effective and safer Internet users.
