Thank you to the parents who attended and gave their time and energy to this process.

#### SENO SNA Review:

Every year our Special Education Needs Organiser comes to the school and reviews our SNA allocation. There are very strict criteria for the allocation and retention of SNAs in a school. Our annual review took place this month and we will find out in May what our allocation for 2018/2019 will be. Every member of our staff is highly valued and goes beyond the call of duty for our students so we hope that we will maintain our current allocation.
